INSPECTION WILL COINCIDE WITH ROLL CALL

All hounds to be inspected for entry in the trial(s) must be presented WITHOUT TAPE, BANDAGES or WRAPPING on the toes, feet, or legs

ELIGIBLE BREEDS AND REGISTRY

Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzoi, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Sloughis, and Whippets may be entered in the regular stakes. All entries shall be individually registered with the American Kennel Club, The National Greyhound Association, the Federation Cynologique Internationale, an ASFA-recognized foreign or ASFA board approved registry, or posses a Critique Registration Number (CRN) from the Society for the Perpetuation of the Desert-Bred Saluki (SPDBS). Limited/Provisional breed entries must be individually registered with the appropriate registry. Currently, Cirneco dell'Etnas, Chart Polskis, Galgos Espanol, Peruvian Inca Orchids, Magyar Agars, and Portugese Podengos are eligible for entry.

- ❖ Late, conditional, unsigned, incomplete or unpaid entries will not be accepted
- ❖ Early-Entries will not be acknowledged by mail; Entries will be acknowledged by e-mail if requested and if an e-mail address is provided
- ❖ Substitutions may be made for hounds lame or in season at the time of roll call
- ❖ Entries shall be refused for First Time Entered Hounds entering Open, Veteran or Limited Stakes that do not have a copy of registration papers (NGA Greyhounds excepted) to accompany a completed, signed and approved certification form. If a hound has earned a title that waives the certification requirement, a copy of that title certificate must accompany the appropriate ASFA form of waiver
- ❖ Hounds may enter SINGLES without having ASFA certification, but must provide a copy of their official registration papers

GENERAL INFORMATION

- All entries must be one year of age or older on the day of the trial
- Stakes will be split if 20 or more entries are present in any one stake at the time of the draw
- Bitches in season, hounds with breed disqualifications, and lame hounds will be excused
- All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible, or braces, unless excused, dismissed or disqualified
- Monorchid, cryptorchid, spayed, or neutered hounds may be entered.
- Hounds not present at the time of Roll Call will be scratched and entry fees will not be refunded
- Electrical-powered, continuous loop lure machine will be used with back-up equipment available
- The lure will consist of light and/or light colored plastic and/or fur.
- Muzzles are not required; it is the responsibility of the owners to determine if their hound should be muzzled

NOTICES

- ALL PERSONS MUST **CLEAN UP AFTER THEIR HOUNDS**. The TCDA and our fellow competitors deserve our respect. If your hound makes a mess, you **MUST** clean it up. Please report violations to the Field Chair
- A **penalty of \$5.00** will be assessed for any loose hounds not competing in the course in progress
- A **return check fee of \$35.00** will be assessed for any check(s) returned for insufficient funds

- This event site has permanent restroom facilities and stall showers. Water for your hounds also is available. Please bring your own shade and/or shelter

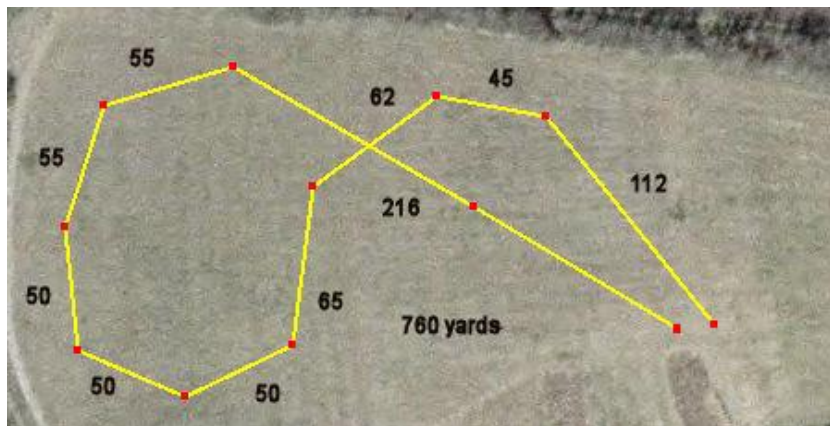


COURSE

RECREATIONAL VEHICLES and OVERNIGHT CAMPING

TCDA has changed its R.V. and Camping Policy beginning JANUARY 1, 2008. NEW TRIPLE CROWN DOG ACADEMY POLICY holds the host club responsible for R.V. and Tent camping FEES. According to the new TCDA fee schedule, RV's may remain on site overnight for a \$20 daily fee - regardless of electrical hook-up (that is, with or without). Tent camping is also allowed overnight for \$5 per night without electricity or \$10 per night with electricity. Please support this and all host clubs by responsibly reporting your payable R.V. and Tent camping fees on arrival. Individuals failing to pay their RV and Tent camping fees before departure may be subject to fines and may be banned from entry in future events.

The Cirneco dell'Etna is one of few ancient breeds that has undergone very little manipulation by man. It has been selected by nature, by the environment and by its use as a rabbit hunter over the three thousand years it has been present in Sicily.

Cirnechi are avid hunters of small game, particularly rabbits, and are required to pass their hunting trial before they are allowed to achieve the title of Italian Champion. The correct pronunciation of this breed is Chir-neck-o or Chir-neck-e for plural.

An extremely hardy breed, free from inherited health problems. Affectionate and friendly, considered easier to train than some of its sighthound cousins. General appearance: Primitive dog type of elegant and slender shape, medium size, not cumbersome, robust, and strong. Cirnechi should be square rather than slightly longer than tall. Temperament is generally outgoing though they can be diffident with strangers entering their home area. They enjoy the company of other dogs and are loving and playful with the owners and children.

Cirnechi are very similar to the Pharaoh hound in appearance and share origins in the Mediterranean basin however there are many differences. Most noticeable is the size: Males range from 46 to 50cm (18.11 to 19.68 in) with a tolerance up to 52 cm (20.41 in) and a weight range of 10 to 12 kg (22.04 to 26.45 lbs). Females range from 42 to 46 cm (16.53 to 18.11 in) with a tolerance up to 50 cm (19.68 in) and a weight range of 8 to 10 kg (17.63 to 22.04 lbs).

The only disqualifying faults are overshot mouth, total depigmentation, and walleye. As with the Pharaoh Hound, the Cirneco color ranges from Light Tan to Chestnut. White markings are allowable.

The Cirneco is an excellent courser and loves to chase the 'lure'. The current goals of the Parent Club are to work towards American Sighthound Field Association (ASFA) and American Kennel Club (AKC) recognition of the breed.
