All hounds will be checked for breed disqualifications

Time of Roll Call will be at the conclusion of Certification Runs or 8:00a whichever time is later

INSPECTION WILL COINCIDE WITH ROLL CALL

All hounds to be inspected for entry in the trial(s) must be presented WITHOUT TAPE, BANDAGES or WRAPPING on the toes, feet, or legs

No pajamas, coats or blankets may be worn by hounds while being inspected

CdECA Members, Field Committee Members and Volunteer Trial Workers may have their hounds inspected at 7:45A.M.by the full inspection committee

ELIGIBLE BREEDS AND REGISTRY

Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzoi, Cirnechi, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Sloughis, and Whippets may be entered in the regular stakes. All entries shall be individually registered with the American Kennel Club, The National Greyhound Association, the Federacion Cynologique Internationale, an ASFA-recognized foreign or ASFA board approved registry, or posses a Critique Registration Number (CRN) from the Society for the Perpetuation of the Desert-Bred Saluki (SPDBS). Limited/Provisional breed entries must be individually registered with the appropriate registry. Currently, Chart Polskis, Galgo Espanoles, Peruvian Inca Orchids, Magyar Agars and Portuguese Podengos are eligible for entry.

- ◆ Late, conditional, unsigned, incomplete or unpaid entries will not be accepted
- ◆ Early-Entries will not be acknowledged by mail; Entries will be acknowledged by e-mail if requested and if an e-mail address is provided
- ◆ Substitutions may be made for hounds lame or in season **at the time of roll call**
- ◆ Entries shall be refused for First Time Entered Hounds entering Open, Veteran or Limited Stakes that do not have a copy of registration papers (NGA Greyhounds excepted) to accompany a completed, signed and approved certification form. If a hound has earned a title that waives the certification requirement, a copy of that title certificate must accompany the appropriate ASFA form of waiver
- ◆ Hounds may enter the SINGLES staked without having ASFA certification, but must provide a copy of their official registration papers

RECREATIONAL VEHICLES and OVERNIGHT CAMPING

Camping is allowed on the site for a fee of \$10/night for RV or tents with no hookups and \$15/night with hookups. Please be forewarned that the disposing of grey water on the facility grounds is forbidden. Fees will be collected at the site

DIRECTIONS

FROM HOUSTON: Take Interstate 10 and head west toward San Antonio. Exit at #720 or Highway 36 and turn north (left) on Texas 36. At the third traffic light (FM 1094) turn left (west) and travel 11.8 miles. (You will pass a blinking light on FM 949 at the 11 mile mark) go past the long white PVC fence on the left; take the 3rd entrance at Paso Fino Rd. There is an electric gate opener—upon entering please wait for the gate to close before continuing to the barn.

FROM BRENHAM: Take Highway 36 to Bellville. Turn South on Hwy 36 (right). Turn right on FM 2429 at the Exxon station (first blinking light); when you come to the stop sign (FM 949), turn right. On the corner of FM 949 and FM 1094 is the Crossroad Tavern. Turn right and 7/10 of a mile from the tavern is a white gate on the left with a PASO FINO sign and Paso Fino Road sign. There is an electric gate opener—upon entering please wait for the gate to close before continuing to the barn.

GENERAL INFORMATION/CONDITIONS FOR ENTRY

- ◇ All entries must be one year of age or older on the day of the trial
- ◇ Stakes will be split into flights by public random draw if 20 or more entries are present in any one stake at the time of the draw
- ◇ Bitches in season, lame hounds and hounds with breed disqualifications will be excused by the inspection committee at roll call.
- ◇ Monorchid, cryptorchid, spayed, or neutered hounds may be entered
- ◇ Hounds with breed disqualification are not eligible to enter except in the Single stake
- ◇ Hounds not present at the time of Roll Call will be scratched and entry fees will not be Refunded
- ◇ Early-entry fees submitted and accepted with early-entries will be refunded in full if the withdrawal of said entries is requested by the hound's owner or agent prior to the closing deadline for early-entries. Requests may be made by time-stamped email to the FTS or by direct contact (phone or in person) with the FTS. No refunds for early-entry fees will be returned after the closing of early-entries unless the entered hound upon inspection is lame or in season
- ◇ Day-of-trial-entry fees submitted and accepted with day-of-trial-entries will be refunded in full if the withdrawal of said entries is requested by the hound's owner or agent prior to the closing deadline for day-of-trial-entries. Requests must be made in person to the FTS. No refunds for day-of-trial-entry fees will be returned after the closing of day-of-trial-entries unless the entered hound upon inspection is lame or in season
- ◇ All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible, or braces, unless excused, dismissed or disqualified

NOTICES

- ◆ **Certifications will be offered BEFORE the trial and will begin at 7:45a. No certifications will be offered after the trial. A \$10 fee is applicable per run.**
- ◆ Fun Runs or Practice Runs will be offered **ON SATURDAY ONLY** as conditions allow. Please notify the FTS that you would like to fun run your hound (s). Please work with us, and we will work with you to fit you into the schedule.
- ◆ **ALL PERSONS MUST CLEAN UP AFTER THEIR HOUNDS.** The facility and our fellow competitors deserve our respect. If your hound makes a mess, you **MUST** clean it up. *Please report violations to the Field Chair*
- ◆ A **penalty of \$5.00** will be assessed for any loose hounds not competing in the course in Progress
- ◆ A **return check fee of \$35.00** will be assessed for any check(s) returned for insufficient Funds
- ◆ Electrical-powered, continuous loop lure machine will be used with back-up equipment Available
- ◆ The lure will consist of light and/or light colored plastic and/or fur.
- ◆ Muzzles are not required; it is the responsibility of the owners to determine if their hound should be muzzled. If a muzzle is used, it must be of a color other than yellow, pink or blue
- ◆ Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to ASFA/CdECA/any hound(s)/other person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site
- ◆ This event site has portable restroom facilities. Water for your hounds also is available. Please bring your own shade and/or shelter
- ◆ Food vendors are pre-arranged for this event site and restaurants are in close proximity in Cat Spring and Bellville
- ◆ CdECA and the facility assume no liability for injury to any person or dog before, during or after these trials

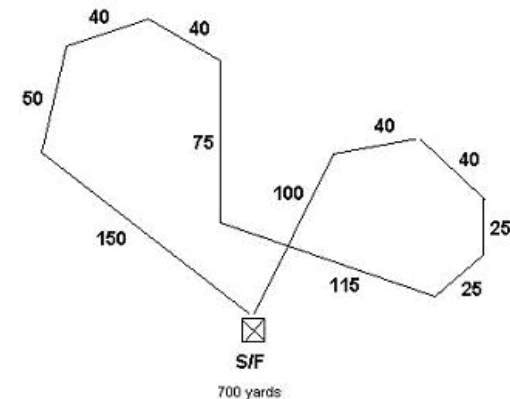

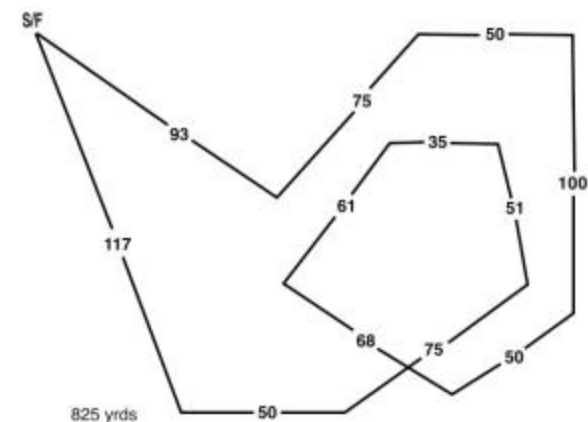
Saturday Course Plan – 700 yards
