DIRECTIONS

FROM HOUSTON: Take Interstate 10 and head west toward San Antonio. Exit at #720 or Highway 36 and turn north (left) on Texas 36. At the third traffic light (FM 1094) turn left (west) and travel 11.8 miles. (You will pass a blinking light on FM 949 at the 11 mile mark) go past the long white PVC fence on the left; take the 3rd entrance at Paso Fino Rd. There is an electric gate opener—upon entering please wait for the gate to close before continuing to the barn.

FROM BRENHAM: Take Highway 36 to Bellville. Turn South on Hwy 36 (right). Turn right on FM 2429 at the Exxon station (first blinking light); when you come to the stop sign (FM 949), turn right. On the corner of FM 949 and FM 1094 is the Crossroad Tavern. Turn right and 7/10 of a mile from the tavern is a white gate on the left with a PASO FINO sign and Paso Fino Road sign. There is an electric gate opener—upon entering please wait for the gate to close before continuing to the barn.

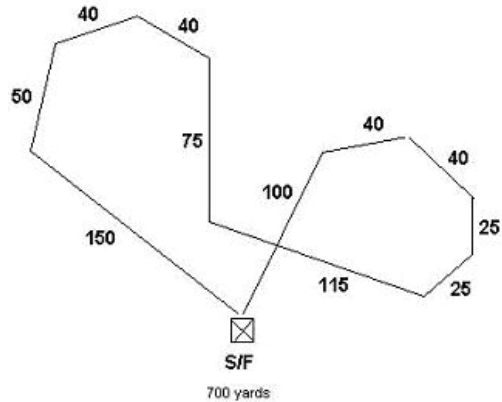
COURSE

*** Field Committee Members and Volunteer Trial Workers may have Their hounds inspected prior to 3:00 p m by the full inspection committee ***

ASFA ELIGIBLE BREEDS AND REGISTRY

Only purebred Cirneco Dell'Etnas registered with the appropriate registry.

Late, conditional, unsigned, incomplete or unpaid entries will not be accepted. Typed signatures on electronic/faxed entries are not acceptable.

Early-Entries will not be acknowledged by mail; Entries will be acknowledged by e-mail if requested and if an e-mail address is provided

Substitutions may be made for hounds lame or in season at the time of roll call

Entries shall be refused for First Time Entered Hounds entering limited stakes that do not have a copy of registration papers to accompany a completed, signed and approved certification form. If a hound has earned a title that waives the certification requirement, a copy of that title certificate must accompany the appropriate ASFA form of waiver

Hounds may enter the SINGLES stake without having ASFA certification, but must provide a copy of their official registration papers

Hounds entering the SINGLES stake may compete with breed disqualifications

STAKES OFFERED

Open Stake	Any eligible sighthound one year of age or older on the day of the trial having met ASFA certification requirements, excluding ASFA Field Champions of record
Field Champion Stake	Any ASFA Field Champion
Veteran Stake	Any eligible hound, having met ASFA Certification requirements, whose age exceeds six years
Single Stake	Any eligible Sighthound including those disqualified to run other stakes
Best in Specialty	Best in Breed shall be Best in Specialty

NOTICES

- ◆ **Certifications will not be offered**
- ◆ ALL PERSONS MUST **CLEAN UP AFTER THEIR HOUNDS**. The facility and our fellow competitors deserve our respect. If your hound makes a mess, you MUST clean it up. *Please report violations to the Field Chair*
- ◆ A **penalty of \$5.00** will be assessed for any loose hounds not competing in the course in Progress
- ◆ A **return check fee of \$35.00** will be assessed for any check(s) returned for insufficient Funds
- ◆ Electrical-powered, continuous loop lure machine will be used with back-up equipment Available
- ◆ The lure will consist of light and/or light colored plastic and/or fur.
- ◆ Muzzles are not required; it is the responsibility of the owners to determine if their hound should be muzzled. If a muzzle is used, it must be of a color other than yellow, pink or blue
- ◆ Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to ASFA/CdECA/any hound(s)/other person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site

- ◆ This event site has portable restroom facilities. Water for your hounds also is available. Please bring your own shade and/or shelter
- ◆ Food vendors are pre-arranged for this event site and restaurants are in close proximity in Cat Spring and Bellville
- ◆ CdECA and the facility assume no liability for injury to any person or dog before, during or after these trials

GENERAL INFORMATION/CONDITIONS FOR ENTRY

- ◇ All entries must be one year of age or older on the day of the trial
- ◇ Stakes will be split into flights by public random draw if 20 or more entries are present in any one stake at the time of the draw
- ◇ Bitches in season, lame hounds and hounds with breed disqualifications will be excused by the inspection committee at roll call.
- ◇ Monorchid, cryptorchid, spayed, or neutered hounds may be entered
- ◇ Hounds with breed disqualification are not eligible to enter except in the Single stake
- ◇ Hounds not present at the time of Roll Call will be scratched and entry fees will not be Refunded
- ◇ Early-entry fees submitted and accepted with early-entries will be refunded in full if the withdrawal of said entries is requested by the hound's owner or agent prior to the closing deadline for early-entries. Requests may be made by time-stamped email to the FTS or by direct contact (phone or in person) with the FTS. No refunds for early-entry fees will be returned after the closing of early-entries unless the entered hound upon inspection is lame or in season
- ◇ Day-of-trial-entry fees submitted and accepted with day-of-trial-entries will be refunded in full if the withdrawal of said entries is requested by the hound's owner or agent prior to the closing deadline for day-of-trial-entries. Requests must be made in person to the FTS. No refunds for day-of-trial-entry fees will be returned after the closing of day-of-trial-entries unless the entered hound upon inspection is lame or in season
- ◇ All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible, or braces, unless excused, dismissed or disqualified
